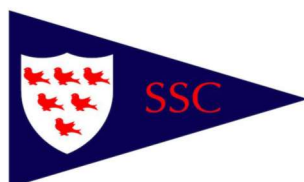

## NOTICE OF RACE

Shoreham SC Regatta

30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020

Organising Authority:

Shoreham Sailing Club (SSC)

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), RYA prescriptions and the relevant Class rules.
- 1.2 In the case of conflict between the Notice of Race (NoR) and the sailing instructions (SI's), the sailing instructions shall prevail. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.3 Competitors will wear personal flotation devices while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be used: this changes Rule 40. Wetsuits or dry-suits are not personal floatation devices.
- 1.4 Any changes to the RRS will be given in the SI's.
- 1.5 Spinnaker numbers are not required. This changes Rule 77 and Appendix G1.3(d).

### 2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all and only members of the Shoreham Sailing Club.
- 2.2 A boat wishing to substitute a helm or a crew after registration shall make prior written request to the race committee to do so. The decision to permit or deny such request shall be entirely at the discretion of the race committee. However, results gained after a change of helm will not be added to previous results.

### 3 REGISTRATION AND FEES

- 3.1 Registration/sign-on shall be made verbally each day at the registration table under the clubhouse balcony.
- 3.2 There will be no Entry Fees for the 2020 Regatta.
- 3.3 Competitors must sign-on each day before going afloat.

### 4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The event comprises of a six (6) race series, intended to be 3 races on Sunday and 3 races on Monday.
- 4.2 At its' discretion, the race committee may change the number of races each day but may not start more than 4 races on either day.
- 4.3 There will be no briefing but a blackboard will display course, wind, tide and shipping movements.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the first race will be 10.25 on both days.
- 4.5 No warning signal will be made after 13.00 on Sunday and 13.30 on Monday.
- 4.6 High water times: Sunday 30 August 10.18 (tbc); Monday 11.05 (5.48)

## 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be published on the SSC website on or before 24<sup>th</sup> August ([www.shorehamsailing.org](http://www.shorehamsailing.org)) and printed copies will be available at registration.

## 6 VENUE

6.1 Shoreham Sailing Club, Soldiers Point, 223 Harbour Way, Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, BN43 5HZ.  
6.2 Racing will normally take place to the West of the harbour entrance.

## 7 PENTALTY SYSTEM

7.1 RRS Rule 44 will apply.

## 8 SCORING

8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series  
8.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
8.3 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 9 PRIZES

9.1 Prizes will be awarded by Shoreham Sailing Club;

- Trophy for the overall winners of General Handicap Fleet
- Trophy for the overall winner of Youth Fleet

9.2 The SSC will provide additional prizes dependent on entries.

## 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone'.  
10.2 By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules or information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;
- their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £2,000,000 or the equivalent per event against third party claims.

## 10.3 Covid 19 additional responsibilities

- The event is only open to members. No visitors, sailing or non-sailing will be admitted to the club area.
- The clubhouse will be closed for the duration of the event.
- Toilet facilities will however will be available but the changing for essential use only
- Please arrive changed for sailing and shower when home.
- Trolleys: Double handers must return their trolleys to their dinghy park spaces. Single handers can leave them clear of the slipway.
