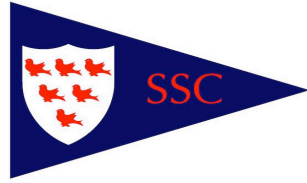

NOTICE OF RACE

Battle of the Beaches and Barts Bash

13th September 2020

Organising Authority:

Shoreham Sailing Club (SSC) and Lancing SC

1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), RYA prescriptions and the relevant Class rules.
- 1.2 In the case of conflict between the Notice of Race (NoR) and the sailing instructions (SI's), the sailing instructions shall prevail. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.3 Competitors will wear personal flotation devices while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be used: this changes Rule 40. Wetsuits or dry-suits are not personal floatation devices.
- 1.4 Any changes to the RRS will be given in the SI's.
- 1.5 Spinnaker numbers are not required. This changes Rule 77 and Appendix G1.3(d).

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The event is open to all members and visitors of Shoreham Sailing Club and Lancing Sailing Club.
- 2.2 A boat wishing to substitute a helm or a crew after registration shall make prior written request to the race committee to do so. The decision to permit or deny such request shall be entirely at the discretion of the race committee. However, results gained after a change of helm will not be added to previous results.

3 ENTRIES AND FEES

- 3.1 Entries shall be made at your club and by sailing past the committee boat.
- 3.2 There will be no Entry Fees for this event, but we encourage you to make a donation of £5 per person to the Andrew Simpson Foundation through the Barts Bash website: <https://www.bartsbash.com/>.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration will take place at your club and by sailing past the committee boat.
- 4.2 The event comprises of a 2 (2) race series.
- 4.3 At its' discretion, the race committee may change the number of races.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the first race will be 11.55.
- 4.5 High water times: Sunday 13 September 08.28 (tbc)

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing instructions will be published on the SSC website on or before 11th September (www.shorehamsailing.org).

6 VENUE

- 6.1 Racing will take place offshore near the Church of the Good Shepherd on Shoreham Beach.

7 PENTALTY SYSTEM

- 7.1 RRS Rule 44 will apply.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will not be awarded but the winner will have the accolade of being winner of Battle of the Beaches 2020.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 10.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone'.

- 10.2 By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules or information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;
- their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £2,000,000 or the equivalent per event against third party claims.

- 10.3 Covid 19 additional responsibilities

- The clubhouses will be closed for the duration of the event.
- Toilet facilities will be available.
